Which bowl of apples will you choose and why?

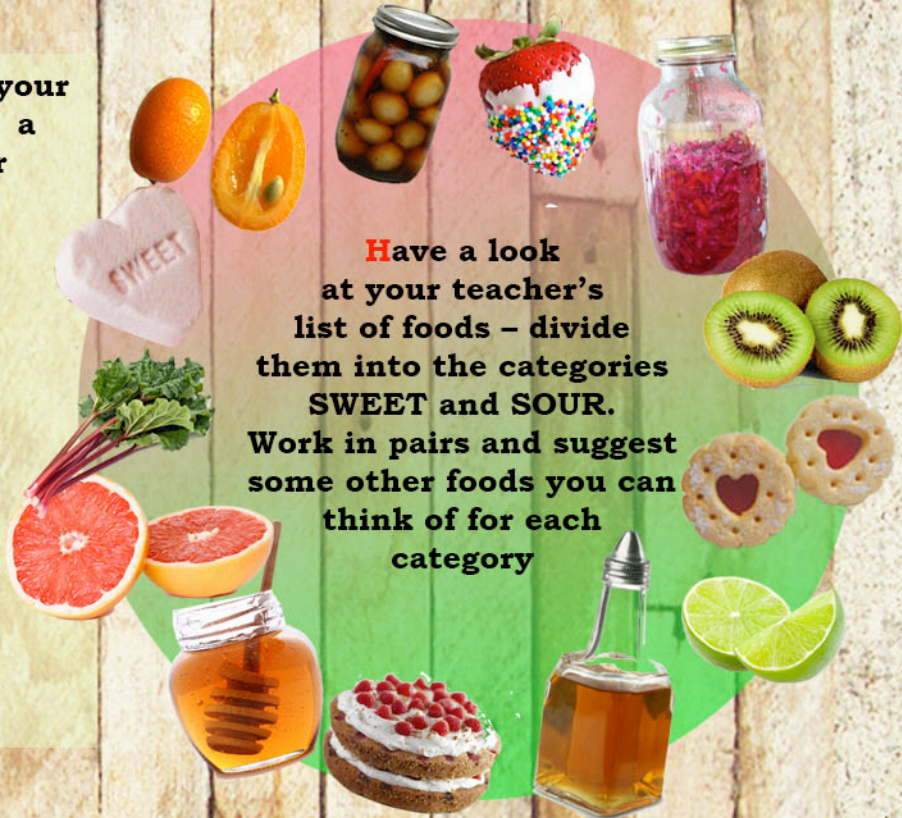
Record your answers on a post-it note and stick it in front of the bowl you've chosen.
